Attractions

The Bund 外滩



The Bund is regarded as the symbol of Shanghai; it is a really beautiful and special place which worth visiting. It starts from the Baidu Bridge to the East Jinling Road. Walking alongside the Bund, on the west shore of the Huangpu River, the Oriental Pearl TV Tower and the Jin Mao Tower can be seen on the opposite side of the Bund.

Nanjing Road 南京路



Nanjing Road is considered to be the 'No.1 commercial street in China, and has been a landmark of the city for a long time.

Oriental Pearl TV Tower 东方明珠塔



The Oriental Pearl TV Tower is the modern symbol of Shanghai. It is also the tallest TV tower in Asia, situated beside the Huangpu River, just opposite the Bund. The Tower has fifteen observatory levels; contains a history museum, a revolving restaurant and a shopping mall.

Yuyuan Garden and City God Temple 豫园 及 上海城隍庙



The Yuyuan Garden features Ming Dynasty and Qing Dynasty architectural styles, it is the largest ancient garden in Shanghai. Located close by the garden is the City God Temple (上海城隍庙).

Beside the temple and the garden, there are a lot of shops where you can find local snacks and traditional arts and crafts.

Jade Buddha Temple 玉佛禅寺



The Jade Buddha Temple is one of the most famous Buddhist shrines in Shanghai. The Temple contains two white jade Buddhist statues brought from Burma in the 19th century. One statue seated and the other in the recumbent position, which symbolise Buddha's attainment of enlightenment and nirvana.

Longhua Pagoda & Longhua Temple 龙华寺



The Longhua Temple was first built in 242 AD during the Three Kingdoms period. It is the oldest and largest temple in Shanghai. The Longhua Pagoda situates in front of the Longhua Temple, its brick body and wooden staircases makes up the main structure of the Longhua Pagoda. Rebuilt several times, it has retained the style of the Song Dynasty.

Shanghai Xin Tian Di is a historical and cultural centre of the city, comprising Shikumen and modern architecture styles. Its exterior retains the antique walls tiles of an old Shanghai building, its interior embodies trendy galleries, boutiques, theme restaurants and bars.

1933 Old Millfun 1933 老场坊



The 1933 Old Millfun was designed by British architect Balfour as a slaughter house for the Shanghai Municipal Committee. The restoration and transformation of 1933 Old Millfun followed the principle of “protective utilisation” and “repairing the site in a way that retains historical appearances”. The first public service platform – Shanghai Design Window, was launched here.

Red Town – Shanghai Sculpture Space 红坊 – 上海城市雕塑艺术中心



Red Town — Shanghai Sculpture Space is a massive area that not only houses several galleries and a sculpture park, but also a growing number of restaurants, cafes, shops and offices. Red Town was originally constructed as a steel plant in 1956 and was renovated few years ago. The red-brick warehouses have been wonderfully preserved and are an essential destination for architecture and sculpture buffs.
